TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE EMERGENCY CLOSURE Meg Lane Burntwood

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Staffordshire County Council being the highway authority responsible for the repair and maintenance of Meg Lane in Burntwood are satisfied that it is necessary to close to all vehicular traffic that length of Meg Lane for its entire length for a period of 21 days from the date of this Notice because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to embankment / carriageway giving way. Assocated works and Traffic Management managed by SCC / Amey Highways

Access will be available for pedestrians and for vehicles being used in connection with the works and for emergency services vehicles and for vehicles requiring access to properties on the length of road which is closed

An alternative route for traffic is available and will be signed on site.
